## DECEMBER 2018 NEWSLETTER

**GRANTS:** The Village of Lima has been awarded two grants for the clean water and infrastructure projects totaling \$3,258,200.00. A grant for \$2,398,200.00 is for the water structure project slated to start in 2020. The second grant is for \$860,000.00 towards a D.E.C. mandated upgrade to the Waste Water Treatment plant.

**LEAF PICK-UP:** Leaves must be in **biodegradable bags** only for pick up.

**SNOW:** As we approach the winter season, we would like to remind everyone that parking on village streets from **2 am to 6 am is prohibited**. If you have a fire hydrant in front of your residence, please help our Volunteer Fire Dept. and keep it cleared of snow.

**CHRISTMAS TREES:** The Village crew will once again be picking up Christmas trees this year. Please place them by the roadside and we will get them as time permits.

**WATER/SEWER RELEVY:** Re-levy cutoff date is Feb. 22, 2019 by 4:00 pm. All unpaid water and sewer bills will be re-levied onto the 2019-20 village taxes after 2/22/2019.

**BUILDING INSPECTOR:** Before starting any home project, you should call the building inspector at 624-7911 to see if your project needs a permit. Please remember that installing wood stoves, gas inserts, pellet or coal stoves require a building permit to be issued by the Village. The permit ensures that the installation is in compliance with the Building Code. Wood stoves and chimneys should be checked and cleaned on a regular basis.

**PARKING:** Please be aware during the winter season that on-street parking is prohibited between **2 AM and 6 AM** on all village streets. During snowfalls in excess of 3 inches, parking on village streets where signage allows overnight parking is prohibited, so village crews can complete the snow removal process. Cars left on the street will be eligible for towing at owner's expense.

**CATS:** We have received many complaints about the large number of roaming cats in the village. It is obvious that many of these cats have been raised indoors and then released outdoors to survive for themselves. This is illegal and inhumane. Please keep your cats indoors.
