MARCH 2019 NEWSLETTER

BRUSH PICK-UP: Will be the week of April 15-19. All brush (only brush will be picked up) and must be cut in manageable lengths (no larger than 6" in diameter and no longer than 10 feet) and placed parallel to the roadside in neat piles before Apr. 15th at 8:00 am. The village will only make one (1) trip down each street. The next brush pick-up will be the week of July 15.

LEAVES: During the Spring and Summer Months, leaves will only be picked up if you put them in brown biodegradable bags. **NO PLASTIC BAGS!** We can't dispose of plastic bags.

REMINDER: Please don't dispose of grease in your drains. In addition, please do not flush disposable wipes into your toilets. They are not flushable. These items can and will cause build-ups in the sewer laterals and mains which could lead to sewer blockage.

FIRE HYDRANTS: Hydrants will be flushed the week of April 15th -19th from 7:30 am to 3:30 pm. Please excuse the inconvenience, as the water may be riley during this time.

FIRE WORKS: The Village and Town of Lima are providing fireworks on Thursday, July 4th, at Mark Tubbs Park starting at 9:45 pm.

BUILDING INSPECTOR: You called 911 because an unthinkable emergency has happened at your home. The first responders have driven past your home several times as they are unable to find it. Your four-inch house numbers are not up or visible to the emergency responders that are there to help you. Help the first responders help you by POSTING your house numbers. HFL SUMMER RECREATION: The camp will be located at HFL Middle School (619 Quaker Meeting House Rd) and bus transportation from and to the Lima Primary School will be available each day of the program. The village has budgeted \$6,000.00 for Summer Recreation. Enrollment will be first come first served. SPRING CLEAN UP: is May 17th and May 18th. **Only two (2) pick-up loads per household.** Hazardous waste, paint, tires, batteries, brush, air conditioners, computer monitors, wire fence and contractor debris will not be accepted. **NO TV'S OR ELECTRONICS.** Collection on May 17th and May 18th from 8 am – noon at the village garage. Senior Citizens (65 years or older) can arrange for pick-up by calling the village office at 624-2210 by 4 pm on May 14.

HYPER-REACH: Emergency contact service allows the Livingston County Emergency Communications Center to quickly send a recorded message to telephones in specific areas and alert residents to any emergency situations that may require immediate action. All hard-wired telephones in Livingston County are automatically listed to receive these alerts. Individuals will need to register their mobile devices with Hyper-Reach in order to receive alerts. VILLAGE DATES – 2019

We schedule a **BRUSH PICK-UP** three (3) times a year. This year they are April 15-19, July 15-19 and September 16-20. Please have your brush out before **8:00 am on the Monday** morning beginning of the week or you will miss pick-up. Leaves, Walnuts and Grass Clippings will **NOT** be picked up unless in biodegradable paper bags. **Please do not put brush out except during brush pick-up weeks.**

Hydrant flushing is April 15th – 19th and September 9th – 13th.

VILLAGE CLEAN-UP DAYS will be May 17th and 18th from 8:00 am until noon at the Village Barns located at 7362 Dublin Ave.

Memorial Day Parade will be May 27th starting at 9:30 am.

July 4th Fireworks will be at Mark Tubbs Park at 9:45 pm.

Scheduled **LEAF PICK-UP** begins around October 15th and ends November 18th or after the first snowfall. Please don't wait until the last minute to get your leaves out. After Nov. 18th all leaves must be bagged or they will not be picked up. Once again walnuts will not be picked up unless in **BIODEGRADABLE BAGS**. Also, please do **NOT** put brush or debris in the leaf piles. We have found lumber, metal, large sticks as well as even a baseball bat in the piles. This will break the leaf machine and stop leaf pick up. If you do have some brush debris, put it in a separate pile **NEXT** to the leaves and we will try to pick it up depending on available time.
