## JUNE 2019 NEWSLETTER

**BRUSH PICK-UP:** Will be the week of July 15th. All brush (only brush will be picked up) must be cut in manageable lengths (no larger than 6" in diameter and no longer than 10 feet) and placed parallel to the roadside in neat piles before July 15<sup>th</sup> at 8:00 am. The village will only make one (1) trip down each street. The next brush pick-up will be the week of September 16th.

**LEAVES:** During the Spring and Summer months, Leaves will only be picked up if you put them in Brown Biodegradable bags. **NO PLASTIC BAGS!!!** We can't dispose of plastic bags.

**FIRE HYDRANTS:** Hydrants will be flushed the week of September 9<sup>th</sup> from 7:30-3:30. Please excuse the inconvenience, as the water may be riley during this time.

**FIRE WORKS:** The Village and Town of Lima are providing fireworks on Thursday, July 4<sup>th</sup>, at Mark Tubbs Park starting at 9:45 pm. No floating Chinese style lanterns will be allowed to be released at the fireworks display.

**PESTICIDES:** Please inform your neighbors when putting down lawn chemicals.

**FARMER'S MARKET:** The Farmer's Market will open on Tuesday, June 25<sup>th</sup> on the Lima Presbyterian Church lawn. Come join us every Tuesday from 3pm – 6pm. Co-Sponsored by Lima and businesses.

**DOG LEASH LAW:** Section 5-14-C states that a dog cannot deposit waste or commit a nuisance on private property, sidewalks, or in Mark Tubbs Park. Please pick up after your dog.

**REMINDER:** Please **DO NOT** dispose of grease in your drains. In addition, please **DO NOT** flush disposable wipes down your toilet. They are **NOT** flushable. These items can and will cause buildups in the sewer laterals and main which could lead to sewage backups.

**WATER RATES:** Due to an increase in the cost of water from the City of Rochester and our upcoming water projects a Public Hearing will be scheduled on July 9<sup>th</sup> at 7:00 pm. to discuss the proposed water rate increases.

Half rate (< 5,001) - \$53.00 /quarter; Full rate (<10,001) - 72.00 /quarter; and an additional \$6.10/1000 gls over 10,000.

Out of District Users: Half rate (<5,001) - \$65.80; Full rate (<10,001) - \$89.22 and an additional \$7.30/1000.
