MOTION

Motion made by Joe Schwing, seconded by John Correll to approve abstracts A-12 for \$40,102.86, F-12 for \$1,678.39, Ambulance -12 for \$9.361.00, G-12 for \$3,361.95, Water Capital Project for \$222,391.14 and sewer capital project for \$8,092.10. Motion unanimously approved.

MOTION

Motion made by John Correll, seconded by Joe Schwing to approve the minutes of Feb. 28, as submitted. Motion unanimously approved.

Fire Department Report was given to the Board. Tim distributed handouts on the Corona Virus issue. This will be posted in the village. He informed the Board that the county Dept. of Health will be the point contact for Livingston County. The mayor will be the spokesperson for the village. The sheriff's department will make the decision as to if and when the Hyper Reach system would be utilized.

WWTP report was given to the Board.

Ben requested authorization to purchase a flow meter to monitor the sewer flow on the east side of town. Cost is approx. \$4500.00 which will be paid for out of the sewer contractual fund.

Motion made by Jerry Warsaw, seconded by Joe Schwing to approve the purchase of the flow meter. Motion unanimously approved.

DAN MARCELLUS: Dan reviewed the preliminary 2020 budget summary for the village's IT needs. He stated that firewalls were the highest priority.

Deputy Mayor Warsaw presented the Village of Lima Cyber Security Acceptable Use Policy.

CEO Report was given to the Board.

Discussion was held on water and sewer inspection & hookup fees for Cobblestone Green development. The village will provide specification for the water meter. Pathstone will be responsible for procurement and installation of the meter. A \$500.00 fee will cover the village inspection of the installation of meter, pit, and tapping of the main supply line.

The \$400.00 park new residence fee will remain at \$400.00.

Discussion was held on the Planning Board meetings necessary for subdivisions.

Motion made by Jerry Warsaw, seconded by Joe Schwing to set the cost for multi-unit project reviews at a cost of \$2500.00. Motion unanimously approved.

Discussion was held on the No Tractor Trailer signs on Evergreen street. Ben will obtain another sign to be placed on the north side of Northeast Conveyor building.

Ambulance report was given to the Board. Jobs Completed by Village Crew was given to the Board.

Ben reported that the water supply line project is progressing. Ben stated that he has set up a tax-exempt Amazon account.

RESOLVED, that the establishment of office working hours as well as the number of working hours to be worked by the Village Clerk/Treasurer, and the Deputy Village Clerk/Treasurer, shall be set and established by the Village Board of Trustees from time to time as it sees fit to do, at any official meeting of said Board of Trustees, and further

RESOLVED, that this Resolution shall be effective immediately upon the adoption of said Resolution by the Village Board of Trustees at a meeting of said Board.
