LEAF PICK-UP: Leaf pick-up has been completed for the year. Please put your leaves (only leaves, no brush) in **biodegradable bags only** for pick up. Bags will be picked up as time permits.

WINTER PARKING: Please be aware during the winter season that on-street parking from **2 am to 6am is PROHIBITED** on **ALL** village streets. During snowfalls in excess of 3 inches, parking on village streets where signage allows overnight parking is **PROHIBITED**, so village crews can complete the snow removal process. Cars left on the street will be eligible for towing at owner's expense.

SNOW: If you have a fire hydrant in front of your residence, please help our Volunteer Fire Department and keep it cleared of snow.

CHRISTMAS TREES: The village crew will once again be picking up Christmas trees this year. Please place them by the roadside and we will get them as time permits. Trees must be free of ornaments, garland, lights, and tree bases.

WATER/SEWER RELEVY: Re-levy cutoff date is **February 19, 2021 by 3:00 pm**. All unpaid water and sewer bills will be re-levied onto the **2020-2021 village taxes after 2/19/2021**. **Local Law #1** states: Any water or sewer accounts unpaid by the re-levy date will be assessed an additional 10%. Please be mindful of it as we cannot accept payments after the re-levy date.

BUILDING INSPECTOR: Before starting any home project, you should call the building inspector at **624-7911** to see if you need a permit. Please remember that installing wood stoves, gas inserts, pellet or coal stoves require a building permit to be issued by the Village. The permit ensures that the installation is in compliance with the Building Code. Wood stoves and chimneys should be checked and cleaned on a regular basis.
