SPRING 2022 NEWSLETTER

BRUSH PICK-UP: Will be the week of April 11th-15th. All brush (only brush will be picked up) must be cut in manageable lengths (no larger than 6" in diameter and no longer than 10 feet) and placed parallel to the roadside in neat piles before Apr. 11th at 8:00 am. The village will make only one (1) trip down each street. The next brush pick-ups will be the weeks of July 11th and Sept. 12th.

LEAVES: During the Spring and Summer months, leaves will only be picked up if you put them in brown biodegradable bags. **NO PLASTIC BAGS!** We can't dispose of plastic bags.

FIRE HYDRANTS: Hydrants will be flushed the week of April 18th – 22nd from 7:30 am to 3:30 pm. Please excuse the inconvenience, as the water may be riley during this time.

FIRE WORKS: The Village and Town of Lima are providing a firework display on Sunday, July 4th, at Mark Tubbs Park starting at 9:45 pm.

HFL SUMMER RECREATION: Will take place from June 29th – Aug 5th at HFL Middle School (619 Quaker Meeting House Rd) and bus transportation to and from the Lima Primary School will be available each day of the program. The village has budgeted \$6,000.00 for Summer Recreation. Enrollment will be first come first served. ELECTRONIC RECYCLING: From time to time our congressmen and senators sponsor an Electronic Recycling event. When we are notified of this it will be posted on our web site. SPRING CLEANUP: is May 20th and 21st. **Only two (2) pick-up loads per household.** Hazardous waste, paint, tires, batteries, brush, air conditioners, computer monitors, wire fence and contractor debris will not be accepted. **NO TV'S OR ELECTRONICS.** Collection on May 20th and 21st is from 8 am to noon at the village garage at 7362 Dublin St. Senior Citizens (65 years or older) can arrange for pick-up on May 19th by calling the village office at 624-2210 by noon on May 18th.

BUILDING INSPECTOR: Open burning other than cooking is prohibited in the village. Please don't forget to obtain building permits, fence permits or pool permits. Pools are defined as any container (blow up pools included) that are capable of holding 24" or more of water depth. A pool also requires a protective fence around it.
